

On September 13, 1999, KLM filed revised tariffs that replaced the language contained in the August 16 filing with the following:

The carrier common line (CCL) rates shown as 12.1.1(A) are interim and subject to refund pursuant to the Commission's orders in Cases No. TO-99-254 and TO-99-511, or as these decisions may be subsequently modified by a final decision on appeal.

On September 14, KLM filed a request for expedited consideration of its tariff filing. Also on September 14, the Commission's Staff filed a Memorandum in which it recommended the Commission approve the tariffs.

The tariff sheets as filed on September 13, unlike those filed on August 16, do comply with the Reports and Orders in Case Nos. TO-99-254 and TO-99-511, and the Commission will approve them. The Commission finds that there is good cause to approve them on less than thirty days' notice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed by KLM Telephone Company on September 13, 1999, and assigned Tariff File No. 200000225 is approved for service on and after September 16, 1999.

2. That this order shall become effective on September 16, 1999.
