**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING OF RECOMMENDATION**

On September 22, 1999, BPS Telephone Company (BPS) submitted a tariff filing designed to add language for returned checks received in payment for services rendered and to add an intrastate intraLATA operator service for 0-calls. The tariff sheets bear an effective date of October 22. On September 24, BPS filed a Motion for Expedited Approval. BPS desires that the effective date of its tariff for Intrastate IntraLATA Operator Service coincide with the termination of the Primary Toll Carrier Plan on October 20. Therefore, BPS requests that the Commission approve its tariff to be effective on October 20, 1999.

BPS's Motion for Expedited Approval states good cause for such treatment as required by 4 CSR 240-2.065(2). In order that the Commission may consider BPS's tariff expeditiously, the Staff of the Public Service Commission will be directed to expedite the filing of its recommendations regarding the tariff.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file its recommendations regarding the tariff of BPS Telephone Company (Tariff File No. 200000270) no later than October 8, 1999.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 8, 1999.
