ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On September 8, 1999, AS Telecommunications, Inc., doing business as ALLSTAR Telecom (ALLSTAR), filed its application for a certificate of service authority to provide resold intrastate interexchange telecommunications services to the public in the state of Missouri. Regulation 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A) requires that all applications include evidence of the registration of the applicant's fictitious name, if any, with the Missouri Secretary of State. ALLSTAR has not provided such evidence with its application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That AS Telecommunications, Inc., doing business as ALLSTAR Telecom, shall, within ten (10) days of the effective date of this Order, file a supplement to its Application containing evidence of the registration of its fictitious name with the Missouri Secretary of State as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A).

2. That this Order shall become effective on September 14, 1999.
