ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 20, 2000, the Commission issued an order directing that the parties attend a prehearing conference on April 12, 2000, and that they jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than April 24, 2000. On April 24, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file a proposed procedural schedule. The motion indicates that Southwestern Bell Telephone Company has advised the Staff that it has decided to withdraw the tariff sheet revisions that are the subject of this case. However, SWBT will not be able to withdraw the tariff sheets before April 24, 2000. Staff requests that the Commission extend the filing date from April 24, 2000, to May 2, Staff states that the extension will not prejudice any party, 2000. may conserve Commission resources, and will provide SWBT with ample time within which to withdraw its tariff sheets.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finds that the request for an extension for filing a proposed procedural should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion for Extension of Time for Filing Procedural Schedule, filed by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission on April 24, 2000, is granted. The deadline for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule is now May 2, 2000.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on May 2, 2000.
