## **ORDER DISMISSING CASE**

On September 13, 1999, Dennis Overall (Overall) filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) against Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), alleging that SWBT charged Overall for an emergency phone call from a pay telephone booth when he asked SWBT to interrupt a busy telephone line. The Commission issued its Notice of Complaint on September 16, 1999, providing 30 days for SWBT to file an answer, or, in the alternative, to file a request for mediation.

On October 14, 1999, SWBT filed its Request for Mediation. On October 21, 1999, the Commission issued its Notice Directing Response to Mediation Request, notifying Overall that if he agreed to the mediation request, that he should notify the Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of the notice. On November 2, 1999, Overall notified the

Commission in writing that he agreed to the mediation. Thus, the Commission entered its Mediation Referral Order on November 10, 1999, which stayed further proceedings until that process could be finished.

On December 20, 1999, Overall sent the Commission a letter entitled "Letter of Dismissal of Complaint." Although Overall did not state in that letter that he wanted to dismiss his complaint, the Commission assumes that is what he wishes to do. Overall stated that he had talked with Jim Levin (Levin) of the University of Missouri-Columbia, Community Mediation Service. Overall stated that he had read the tariff of SWBT which allowed them to charge \$1.85 for a line interrupt.

On December 30, 1999, Levin sent a letter to the Commission advising that he had spoken with Overall. Levin stated that Overall was ". . . satisfied that [SWBT] acted within the limits of their tariff when [SWBT] charged him a fee to interrupt a busy line." Levin stated that Overall had indicated that he wished to dismiss his complaint against SWBT.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116 states, in part:

An applicant or complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties....

There has been no prepared testimony filed or oral evidence offered in this case. Thus, the Commission will dismiss this case.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Complaint filed on September 13, 1999, by Dennis
Overall against Southwestern Bell Telephone Company is dismissed.

- 2. That this order shall become effective on January 28, 2000.
- 3. That this case may be closed on January 31, 2000.
