ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO RESCHEDULE PREHEARING CONFERENCE

By Order issued on May 24, 2000, the Commission scheduled a prehearing conference for June 29. On May 30, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed a Motion to Reschedule Prehearing Conference. SWBT indicates that its counsel will be unavailable on June 29. The motion requests that the hearing be rescheduled for June 27. The motion states that all other parties have indicated that rescheduling the prehearing for June 27 is acceptable.

After considering SWBT's motion, the Commission concludes that the prehearing scheduled for June 29 should be rescheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's Motion to Reschedule Prehearing Conference is granted.

2. That the Prehearing Conference previously scheduled for June 29, 2000, is rescheduled for June 27, 2000, beginning at 10:00 a.m.
