

**ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE ANNUAL REPORT OUT OF TIME**  
**AND DIRECTING STAFF FILING**

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-10.080(1), "[a]ll public utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file an annual report with the commission on or before April 15 of each year."

On May 4, 2000, Teleglobe USA Inc. ("USA") filed a motion with the Commission requesting permission to file its 1999 annual report out of time. USA stated that it filed its report timely on April 10, 2000, but that the report was promptly returned to USA due to the format of the financial information. USA resubmitted the report with its motion on May 4, 2000. No objections to USA's motion to file out of time were received.

On May 4, 2000, USA submitted a proprietary version of its annual report under seal and a redacted public version for public record. USA states that certain of its financial information is nonpublic and that disclosure could harm its competitive interests. USA, in its motion, requests that the confidential and proprietary financial information be filed and maintained under seal.

The Commission finds that good cause exists to permit filing of USA's annual report out of time, and the Commission will grant USA's motion for leave to file its annual report out of time. The Commission further finds that prior to ruling the USA's request for confidential treatment of certain financial information, it will request the Commission's Staff to review the request and file its recommendation.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Teleglobe USA Inc.'s May 4, 2000, motion requesting permission to file its annual report out of time is granted, and the annual report deadline requirement of 4 CSR 240-10.080 is waived and the filing of Teleglobe USA Inc.'s annual report on May 4, 2000, is approved.

2. That the Commission's Staff shall review Teleglobe USA Inc.'s request for confidential treatment of certain financial information and file a recommendation regarding the request no later than June 22, 2000.

3. That this order shall become effective on May 23, 2000.


