

APPLICATION

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company (hereinafter "KCPL"), and, pursuant to Sections 393.190, 393.200, 393.210, and 393.250 RSMo 1994,<sup>1</sup> and 4 CSR 240-2.060(1), (4), (7), (8), (9), (11), (12) and (15) and Section 32 of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935, as amended, ("PUHCA") respectfully requests an order from the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") that grants KCPL authority, *inter alia*, to restructure and reorganize itself, merge, transfer assets, and form subsidiary corporations, as more particularly described herein.

Summary of Restructuring Plan

KCPL proposes to separate its generation assets from its transmission, distribution, and customer service assets by creation of separate affiliated companies owned by a common holding company ("HoldingCo"). What is today a vertically integrated electric utility company will be separated into three companies – a Holding Company referred to herein as "HoldingCo", a

distribution and transmission company, referred to herein as "KCPL Delivery" and a generation company referred to herein as "KCPL Power." KCPL Delivery and KCPL Power will be wholly owned subsidiaries of HoldingCo.<sup>2</sup> KCPL anticipates that this exchange will be considered a tax-free reorganization and will not require shareholder approval. KCPL's existing corporate structure, and the corporate structure immediately following the completion of the restructuring plan proposed herein, are shown in Appendix No. 1, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Following the completion of the restructuring transaction, KCPL Delivery will operate as a regulated "electrical corporation" and "public utility" under the jurisdiction of the Commission and will provide all of the necessary noncompetitive products and services for the provision of electric transmission and distribution service. KCPL Power will provide competitive wholesale generation energy supply at market-based rates<sup>3</sup> and will be designated an Exempt Wholesale Generator (EWG) under PUHCA.

KCPL Power will supply KCPL Delivery with power and energy pursuant to a Power Supply Agreement. Pursuant to that agreement KCPL Power will supply electric energy at wholesale under terms and conditions that will ensure reliable and reasonably priced electric power will be available for distribution by KCPL Delivery to its electric utility customers. It is anticipated that, to the extent practicable given available generation and transmission capacity, KCPL Delivery also will request

competitive bids from all interested suppliers of electric energy to supply new and existing load requirements.

KLT Inc., an existing unregulated subsidiary of KCPL, will be owned by HoldingCo.<sup>4</sup>

In Case No. ER-99-313, the Commission approved a stipulation that, among other things, precluded KCPL, the Commission Staff or the Office of the Public Counsel from requesting, prior to September 1, 2001, a general increase or decrease in or refunds of the Company's retail rates that would be effective prior to March 1, 2002. The transfer of generating assets from KCPL Delivery to KCPL Power will be at net book value. The price contained in the Power Supply Agreement will be based on KCPL Power's embedded costs. For those reasons, KCPL's position is that this request has no effect on the above-described moratorium.

#### **Rationale for the Restructuring**

While there are multiple reasons for KCPL to request this business separation, the overriding rationale is that the electric industry is in the midst of a major transition and the Company must structure itself to best meet the challenges of this transition.

Several notable events at the wholesale and retail level, aimed at replacing the existing regulated monopolies with competition, are shaping the future of this industry. The Energy Policy Act of 1992 paved the way for competition at the wholesale level by creating a new class of electric suppliers -- EWGs. For the first time, entities other than existing utility companies were able to sell electricity in the wholesale market. To further facilitate this process, the Federal Energy Regulatory

Commission (FERC) in its landmark Order 888 issued in December 1996, required investor-owned utilities to file tariffs under which anyone could use their transmission system to gain access to wholesale electric customers. As a direct result of these events, a new market for wholesale electricity was born. Over the past few years, trade in this wholesale market has grown tremendously. For example, sales by power marketers have grown from 234 million MWh in 1996 to approximately 1.8 billion MWh in 1999.

Events at the retail level have been just as dramatic. Starting with New Hampshire in May 1996, 25 states have approved plans (legislative and/or regulatory) for retail electric competition. These states represent over 60% of the population of the United States. As of May 1, 2000, 13 of these states have either partially or fully opened their states to retail competition, with the remaining 12 to be opened by July 1, 2002.

KCPL expects this trend towards retail competition to continue. Although the trend started primarily in those states with higher than average electricity prices, it now includes lower cost states such as Montana and Texas. Three states neighboring KCPL's service territory have legislation in place for retail competition – Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Illinois. Retail competition started in Illinois in October 1999. Retail electric customers in Arkansas have the right to choose an alternative provider of electricity starting January 1, 2002. Oklahoma starts July 1, 2002.

While retail competition has not yet come to Missouri or Kansas, the long process required for such change started a few years ago. The Missouri Public Service Commission recognized the need to thoroughly investigate the implications of retail electric competition and in 1997 formed the Retail Electric Competition Task Force. The Task Force did not reach any conclusions as to whether Missouri should allow retail competition, but did recognize a substantial number of issues

requiring resolution before competition. One of those issues was business separation for existing utilities.

Like Missouri, Kansas recognized the need to study issues related to retail competition and in 1996 formed the Kansas Retail Wheeling Task Force. The Staff of the Kansas Corporation Commission participated in this process. While this Task Force did not reach a consensus as to whether Kansas should allow retail competition, most members shared the opinion that retail competition is inevitable due to several factors:

- Pressure exerted by multiple constituency groups (i.e., industrial customers)
- Retail competition in other states
- Congressional activity
- Recent FERC orders to open wholesale competition

One conclusion of the Task Force was that divestiture was not a necessary precondition for restructuring but that at a minimum functional separation and standards of conduct would be necessary.<sup>5</sup> KCPL's request to structurally separate delivery services from generation services is consistent with this conclusion.

Given these developments, it is quite possible that retail competition will come to Missouri and Kansas in the foreseeable future. For the past several legislative sessions, legislation has been introduced in Missouri and Kansas to allow retail electric competition. Throughout the discussions regarding this legislation, a consensus has developed that an important factor in ensuring that alternative providers can gain equal access to customers is to functionally separate delivery services

from competitive services. In this case, KCPL is proposing to go beyond functional separation – i.e., it is proposing to separate structurally.

To summarize, KCPL wants not only to be prepared for retail competition, but also wants to facilitate the transition by promoting a more competitive wholesale market in the region. KCPL has long advocated that a precursor to effective retail competition is an effective regional wholesale market. Separating delivery services from generation services, and opening up retail load requirements to competitive bidding, place KCPL and its customers in the best possible position for the evolving electric industry.

#### **Potential Benefits of the Restructuring for KCPL Customers**

KCPL anticipates benefits for retail electric customers in the separation of KCPL into KCPL Delivery, KCPL Power, and HoldingCo. Because KCPL views this initial application as the beginning of a process of investigating alternatives and of negotiation between interested stakeholders, benefits will become more defined as a result of the procedural process described below. However, as referenced above, KCPL anticipates that at the successful completion of this business separation process, all incremental power requirements for native retail load will be competitively bid. This includes both requirements for load growth and replacement power as existing purchase power agreements expire. KCPL also anticipates a portion of all of its existing retail load requirements will be competitively bid to the extent practicable given available generation and transmission capacity. In addition, KCPL expects this process to result in some form of performance-based regulation for KCPL Delivery that provides strong incentives to efficiently manage delivery service and to acquire reliable power and the best available price.

### **Potential Benefits of the Restructuring for KCPL Shareholders**

KCPL anticipates this business separation process will result in increased value for shareholders as well. Primarily this increased value will result from financial community recognition of the value of the three separate businesses – power generation, power delivery and other competitive businesses. To the extent that KCPL can effectively grow its power business, its regulated delivery service, and its other competitive businesses, the value will be reflected in HoldingCo's share price. And, as discussed above, this business separation helps position KCPL for the evolving electric industry. To the extent KCPL is better prepared to face the new electric business environment, the better off the owners of KCPL will be.

### **Potential Benefits of the Restructuring for the Public Interest**

KCPL's goal is that 1) KCPL Power will sell as much of its power at market-based rates on the wholesale market as soon as possible, and 2) KCPL Delivery will bid as much of its power requirements as possible as soon as possible. KCPL believes that these actions will stimulate the regional wholesale market and will result in more competition. To the extent this occurs, it will benefit not only the customers of KCPL Delivery, but also Missouri customers of other investor-owned utilities, municipalities and rural electric cooperatives that purchase wholesale power.

### **Proposed Procedure and Schedule**

This filing is unprecedented in the State of Missouri. There are many complex issues to be resolved, some of which the Commission and its staff never have been asked to address in a context such as this. Recognizing this, KCPL believes these issues can be addressed more efficiently and effectively with a procedure that is as collaborative as possible. Specifically, as described in more detail below, KCPL proposes that this case be divided into four phases, defined by filings that KCPL



will commit to make by dates certain. Following each date, workshops and technical conferences would be convened to address, and hopefully resolve, the issues raised by each filing. These workshops and technical conferences would be open to all parties. Filings and a hearing addressing any unresolved issues would occur at the end of the process. This procedure was used in KCPL's most recent rate design case, Case No. EO-94-199, and resulted in an unanimous stipulation.

The following dates represent KCPL's suggested procedural schedule. In a separate motion filed contemporaneously with this Application, KCPL has asked the Commission to convene a prehearing conference to discuss procedure following the expiration of the intervention deadline in this case. The following description of the four filings is not exhaustive. It is intended to include only the major components of each filing.

*Phase I -- Organizational Filing*

KCPL will file testimony and exhibits regarding the following on August 15, 2000:

- A complete description of the organizational structure of the companies. This description will include all existing major functions currently performed, and describe any additional functions required for operation of the separate businesses. This information will demonstrate that each business has access to the services required to maintain or enhance customer service, reliability and reasonable prices.
- Form of merger agreement between KCPL and HoldingCo's subsidiary to form KCPL Delivery.

*Phase II -- Accounting Filing*

KCPL will file testimony and exhibits regarding the following on October 16, 2000:

- A detailed description of the assets to be allocated to each business, along with the corresponding book value.
- Form of agreement to transfer assets from KCPL Delivery to KCPL Power.
- A functional separation of KCPL's current revenue requirement.
- A description of the accounting system along with a cost allocation manual describing how costs will be directly assigned and allocated to individual businesses.
- Forms of agreement for affiliate transactions, internal affiliate procedures, and any necessary requests for waivers or determinations under affiliate transaction regulations.

### *Phase III – Financial Filing*

KCPL will file testimony and exhibits regarding the following on December 18, 2000:

- Market analysis defining the relevant market and assessing, among other items, 1) transmission capacity, 2) current and proposed generation, and 3) sales and market prices.
- A proposed bidding process and timeframe for KCPL Delivery to use in procuring energy and capacity for retail load on a competitive basis.
- A proposed form of Power Supply Agreement between KCPL Power and KCPL Delivery.
- An evaluation of generation asset valuation and the effects it may have, if any, on the Power Supply Agreement.
- Whether there is a need to review and address the provision and pricing of transmission and ancillary services.
- A proposed mechanism designed to provide a strong incentive for KCPL Delivery to acquire the most reliable and economical capacity and energy available.
- The expected capitalization for each company and estimated transaction and implementation costs, including refinancing costs. Plans describing the refinancing process necessary to implement the restructuring.
- An assessment of any tax implications associated with the restructuring.
- To the extent possible, a financial analysis quantifying customer benefits associated with the restructuring.

### *Phase IV – Retail Filing*

KCPL will file testimony and exhibits regarding the following on March 19, 2001:

- A proposed mechanism designed to provide a strong incentive for KCPL Delivery to manage distribution services in the most reliable and economical manner reasonably possible.
- Any necessary changes to KCPL's current tariffs.
- Any Code of Conduct provisions related to KCPL's restructuring as an exempt holding company.
- An assessment of the implications of the Company's restructuring for retail competition in Missouri.

### **Summary of Restructuring Transactions**

In order to accomplish this proposed restructuring and reorganization in a non-taxable manner, KCPL proposes the following:

- (a) KCPL will form a new subsidiary of KCPL ("HoldingCo") that will ultimately become the parent holding company for KCPL's regulated and competitive business

subsidiaries. KCPL anticipates that HoldingCo will be an exempt holding company, pursuant to Section 3(a)(1) of PUHCA;

(b) HoldingCo, in turn, will create a subsidiary that will merge with KCPL, and form KCPL Delivery. Current KCPL shareholders will exchange each share of KCPL stock for one share of HoldingCo stock. HoldingCo will be a publicly held corporation that will own 100 percent (100%) of the stock of KCPL Delivery. KCPL Delivery will spin off the stock of KLT Inc. to HoldingCo; and

(c) KCPL Delivery will form a new subsidiary ("KCPL Power") that will ultimately become a generation company. Following the completion of the restructuring transaction, KCPL Power will operate as a competitive supplier of capacity, energy and ancillary services and as an EWG. KCPL Delivery will transfer KCPL's existing generation assets to KCPL Power at net book value. KCPL Power will issue debt, the proceeds of which will be used to pay off debt of KCPL Delivery. This transfer will allow the formation of a competitive generation company with essentially the same asset value as KCPL's existing generation assets. KCPL Delivery will dividend or spin off KCPL Power to HoldingCo. As a result, KCPL Power will become a direct, wholly owned subsidiary of HoldingCo.

#### **Request for Authorization**

In support of this Application, KCPL states as follows:

1. KCPL is a Missouri corporation in good standing in all respects, with its principal office and place of business located at 1201 Walnut, Kansas City, Missouri 64106, e-mail: [www.kcpl.com](http://www.kcpl.com), telephone: (816) 556-2785, fax: (816) 556-2787. KCPL is engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution, and sale of electric energy and power in those areas in

Missouri certificated to it by the Missouri Public Service Commission (hereinafter "Commission"), including the City of Kansas City, Missouri, as well as areas of eastern Kansas. KCPL is an "electrical corporation" and "public utility" as those terms are defined in Section 386.020(15) and (42), RSMo Supp. 1999, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission as provided by law. KCPL provides electric service to approximately 227,000 residential customers and approximately 31,500 commercial and industrial customers in Missouri. KCPL's Certificate of Good Standing is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Appendix No. 2.

3. KCPL's Missouri service area is located in western Missouri, principally in Kansas City, Missouri, and its environs. Appendix No. 3, attached hereto and incorporated herein, contains

maps of KCPL's Missouri service area. Appendix No. 4, attached hereto and incorporated herein, contains the metes and bounds description of KCPL's existing certificated area.

4. A copy of the Agreement of Merger ("Merger Agreement"), between KCPL and HoldingCo's subsidiary to form KCPL Delivery, in substantially final form, will be late-filed as a part of KCPL's proposed Phase I filing as described above. Pursuant to the Merger Agreement, KCPL and a subsidiary of HoldingCo will merge to form KCPL Delivery, which will become a regulated "electrical corporation" and "public utility" serving in KCPL's existing service area under tariffs.

5. A copy of the Agreement of Transfer between KCPL Delivery and KCPL Power ("Transfer Agreement"), in substantially final form, will be late-filed as a part of KCPL's proposed Phase II filing as described above. Pursuant to the Transfer Agreement, KCPL Delivery proposes to transfer to KCPL Power all of KCPL's existing generation assets and facilities (which will be described in the Transfer Agreement). This transfer will be made at the net book value of the assets transferred.

6. KCPL Power will not be an "electrical corporation" as that term is defined in Section 386.020(15), RSMo Supp. 1999, inasmuch as it will sell electric power exclusively at wholesale, and thus, will not be engaged in the sale of electric power at retail to the general public. See, e.g., State ex rel. Danciger v. Public Service Commission, 205 S.W. 36 (Mo. 1918). Subject to approval by the FERC, KCPL Power will sell wholesale power at market-based rates, as well as providing wholesale power to KCPL Delivery pursuant to the Power Supply Agreement at embedded cost rates. The FERC will be asked for a determination that KCPL Power is an EWG, as that term is defined in Section 32 of PUHCA, for the purpose of engaging in the business of owning and/or

operating eligible electric generation facilities and selling electric energy at wholesale to other parties, including KCPL Delivery. Pursuant to an Agreement of Transfer, and such other documents of conveyance as may be required, KCPL Delivery will transfer, convey, and assign to KCPL Power all of KCPL Delivery's rights, title, and interest in all of its generating assets, including associated operating permits and authorities and leasehold interests. KCPL Power will thereafter own and operate said facilities. Existing contracts to purchase power will be retained by KCPL Delivery.

7. KCPL Delivery will enter into a Power Supply Agreement with KCPL Power to purchase from KCPL Power electric energy at wholesale under terms and conditions that will ensure a steady, affordable, and reliable source of electric power for distribution by KCPL Delivery to its electric utility customers. A copy of the Power Supply Agreement, in substantially final form, will be late-filed as a part of KCPL's proposed Phase III filing as described above. KCPL Delivery also will seek competitive bids for electric energy from all interested suppliers for both new and existing load requirement to the extent practicable given available generation and transmission capacity.

8. Pursuant to Section 32(c) of PUHCA, this Commission must make certain findings before some of KCPL's generation facilities may be transferred to an EWG. Specifically, if, as of October 24, 1992, a retail rate was in effect in connection with the construction of a generation facility or electricity produced by the facility, that facility can be transferred to an EWG only if every state utility commission with jurisdiction over the rate determines that allowing the transfer 1) will benefit consumers, 2) is in the public interest, and 3) does not violate state law.

9. Pursuant to Section 32(k) of PUHCA, this Commission also must make certain findings before KCPL Delivery may enter into a contract with an affiliated EWG (i.e., KCPL Power)

to purchase electric energy at wholesale. Specifically, every state commission with jurisdiction over KCPL Delivery's rates must determine that:

- it has sufficient authority, resources and access to the books and records of the electric utility company (KCPL Delivery) and any relevant associate, affiliate or subsidiary company to exercise its duties under state law with respect to the retail rates of the electric utility company;
- the transaction will benefit consumers, does not violate state law, and would not give the EWG an unfair competitive advantage because of its relation with the electric utility company, and;
- the transaction is in the public interest.

In addition, the provisions of Section 393.190(1) require that the Commission make a determination that the proposed asset transfer is not detrimental to the public interest. See State ex rel. City of St. Louis v. Public Service Commission, 73 S.W.2d 393, 400 (Mo. banc 1934); State ex rel. Martigney Creek Sewer Company v. Public Service Commission, 537 S.W.2d 388, 399 (Mo. banc 1970); State ex rel. Fee Fee Trunk Sewer, Inc. v. Litz, 596 S.W.2d 466, 468 (Mo.App. 1980). Finally, the provisions of Section 393.190(2) require that the Commission make a determination that the owning of more than 10 percent (10%) of the stock of KCPL Delivery by HoldingCo is not detrimental to the public interest. See State ex rel. City of St. Louis v. Public Service Commission, 56 S.W.2d 398 (Mo. 1932).

10. Pursuant to Chapters 386 and 393 and the Commission's rules and regulations, the Commission has broad statutory authority over the determination of retail electric rates by electrical corporations and the authority to access the books and records of KCPL and any relevant affiliates with regard to any matter affecting retail electric rates. In addition, the Commission has a large staff of professional accountants, engineers, economists, attorneys, financial analysts, and management

specialists to advise it in this regard. Thus, the Commission has both the authority and the resources to make the determinations required by PUHCA as set forth in paragraphs 8 and 9.

11. As described above, the proposed transactions are not detrimental to the public interest and will in fact benefit consumers and the public interest. The proposed transaction, including the Merger Agreement, Transfer Agreement and the proposed Power Supply Agreement, will ensure a steady, affordable, and reliable source of electric power at just and reasonable rates for distribution by KCPL Delivery to its customers. KCPL Delivery will request competitive bids for new and existing power requirements from all interested suppliers to the extent practicable given available generation and transmission capacity. As a result, customers will obtain the benefit of the most competitive sources of power available in the wholesale market.

12. Estimates of the impact of the proposed merger between KCPL and KCPL Delivery, the documents generated relative to the analysis of the merger and an assessment of the relative risk regarding items that impact KCPL's Missouri operations will be provided to the parties throughout the course of this proceeding.

13. KCPL's plan for debt and preferred stock capitalization as part of the restructuring transaction will be late-filed as a part of KCPL's proposed Phase III filing as described above. That plan will describe the issuance of securities that will allow the capitalization of the HoldingCo and the new subsidiary companies in a manner consistent with the public interest. Pro forma capitalization levels proposed for HoldingCo, KCPL Delivery, KCPL Power, and KLT also will be late-filed as a part of KCPL's proposed Phase III filing.



14. A certified copy of the resolutions of the Board of Directors of KCPL authorizing the Company to proceed with implementation of the restructuring is attached hereto as Appendix No. 5 and incorporated herein by reference.

15. The proposed transactions will not result in the relocation or retirement of any structures, facilities, or equipment which are proposed to be transferred to KCPL Power and which are subject to ad valorem taxes. To the extent possible, KCPL will attempt to estimate whether there will be an impact upon the tax revenues of the political subdivisions as a result of the creation of an unregulated generation subsidiary (KCPL Power), and this estimate will be late-filed as a part of KCPL's proposed Phase III filing as described above.

16. Pro forma balance sheets and income statements for KCPL, HoldingCo, KCPL Delivery, and KCPL Power with adjustments showing the effects of the proposed restructuring and capitalization plans will be late-filed as a part of KCPL's proposed Phase III filing as described above. Copies of filings with other regulatory agencies related to the restructuring proposal will be provided to the Commission when they are available.

17. Should the Commission determine that, as a result of creating KCPL Delivery, a new certificate or certificates of public convenience and necessity should be issued to KCPL Delivery pursuant to Section 393.170, then KCPL requests that such certificate or certificates be issued to KCPL Delivery and that the Commission waive the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(A)-(E).

Should the Commission determine that, as a result of the merger creating KCPL Delivery, a change of electrical suppliers will occur which requires specific Commission approval pursuant to Section 393.106, then KCPL requests that such a change be authorized and that the Commission waive the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.060(15).

18. None of the proceeds of the issuance of the common stock, debt, and other securities related to the restructuring plan will be subject to the fee schedule in Section 386.300 because they will involve the issuance of common stock, or the retirement or replacement of existing debt securities.

19. KCPL has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates which has occurred within three (3) years of the date of the Application, except as identified on Appendix No. 6, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

20. No annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

21. The Commission has explicit statutory authority to grant KCPL's requests pursuant to the above-cited statutes.

**WHEREFORE**, Kansas City Power & Light Company respectfully requests the Commission to issue its Order:

1. Granting KCPL the authority to restructure and reorganize itself as discussed herein, and form the following subsidiary corporations:

(a) a subsidiary of KCPL that will ultimately become the holding company for KCPL's existing regulated and competitive business subsidiaries ("HoldingCo");

(b) a subsidiary of HoldingCo, into which KCPL will merge its existing transmission and electric distribution assets, and operate as a public utility company providing regulated transmission and electric distribution services following the completion of the restructuring transaction;

(c) a subsidiary of KCPL Delivery that will ultimately become a competitive generation energy provider ("KCPL Power") and a wholly owned subsidiary of HoldingCo.

2. Granting KCPL the authority to merge with the HoldingCo subsidiary to form KCPL Delivery.

3. Granting HoldingCo the authority to own more than ten percent (10%) of the common stock of KCPL Delivery.

4. Granting KCPL Delivery the authority to assign and transfer certain assets and facilities associated with KCPL's existing generation functions to KCPL Power, as more fully described herein.

5. Granting KCPL Delivery the authority to enter into, execute, and perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement of Transfer by and between KCPL Delivery and KCPL Power.

6. Granting KCPL Delivery the authority to enter into, execute, and perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of the proposed Power Supply Agreement by and between KCPL Delivery and KCPL Power.

7. Granting KCPL Delivery, if necessary, the authority to provide electric service in Missouri pursuant to a new certificate or certificates of public convenience and necessity.

8. Granting KCPL Delivery, if necessary, the authority to provide electric service in the current service areas of KCPL as a public utility subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission and authorizing the transfer of all KCPL customers to KCPL Delivery as contemplated by Section 393.106.


9. Granting KCPL Delivery the authority to provide electric service in accordance with the rules, regulations, rates, and tariffs of KCPL as may be on file with, and approved by, the Commission as of the effective date of the closing of the restructuring transaction or as otherwise determined by the Commission as a result of this proceeding.

10. Granting all approvals necessary to implement the restructuring plan described herein.

11. Making the necessary determinations pursuant to Sections 32 (c) and (k) of PUHCA as described herein.

12. Granting such other relief as may be deemed necessary and appropriate to accomplish the purposes of the Application and to consummate the restructuring transaction, as described herein, in accordance with the Merger Agreement, Transfer Agreement, proposed Power Supply Agreement, and other related agreements necessary to consummate the restructuring transaction.
