**ORDER EXTENDING FILING DATE**

On April 7, 1999, Ozark filed a motion to extend the date on which the proposed procedural schedule is due. Ozark states that, as a result of discussions during a conference call in which all parties except the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) participated, it believes that postponing the filing of a proposed procedural schedule to allow further discussions would be beneficial. Ozark filed the motion on behalf of the parties that participated in the conference call, but did not state whether Public Counsel objected to the extension. Accordingly, the Commission allowed Public Counsel ten days to respond to the Motion to Extend Filing Date. Since it did not, the Commission will grant the requested extension.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than May 10, 1999. The procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony and for a hearing.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 1999.
