ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On December 30, 1998, the Commission approved the application of Frontier Corporation (Frontier), Allnet Communication Services d/b/a Frontier Communications Services (FCS), and Frontier Communications International, Inc. (FCI) permitting the reorganization and transfer of assets from FCI to FCS. In its December 30, 1998 order, the Commission directed Frontier to file a copy of the written notice sent to its Missouri customers by February 13, 1999. On February 18, 1999, the Commission granted Frontier an extension of the time within which to file the proposed notice to customers. The Commission directed Frontier to file a copy of the notice provided to customers with the Commission within five days after the written notice is sent to the customers. On July 22, 1999, Frontier filed a status report at the request of the Commission.

The Commission directs Frontier, FCI, and FCS to file a copy of the written notice sent to customers, or a case status report if no notice has yet been sent to customers, no later than 3:00 p.m. on April 19, 2000.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Frontier Corporation, Allnet Communication Services d/b/a Frontier Communications Services, and Frontier Communications International, Inc. shall file a copy of the written notice provided to customers, or if no notice has yet been sent, a case status report, no later than 3:00 p.m. on April 19, 2000.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on April 14, 2000.
