## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE STATUS REPORT

On June 17, 1999, JATO Communications Corp. and JATO Operating Corp. filed a Joint Application to Transfer Assets and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from JATO Communications Corp. to its subsidiary, JATO Operating Corp. On October 29, 1999, in Case No. TA-2000-141, JATO Operating Corp. was granted certificates of service authority to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunications services. JATO Operating Corp.'s tariff to provide interexchange services was approved by the Commission with an effective date of December 20, 1999. JATO Operating Corp.'s tariff to provide local exchange services was approved by the Commission with an effective date of January 14, 2000.

Despite the activity regarding JATO Operating Corp in Case No. TA2000-141, nothing has been filed in this case since a Tax Impact
Statement was filed by the applicants on July 23, 1999. The applicants
have not filed any additional pleadings and the Staff of the Commission
has not filed any recommendations regarding the application. The
Commission would like to move this case forward. Therefore, the Staff

of the Commission will be directed to file a case status report informing the Commission of the status of the application. As part of its case status report, Staff shall indicate whether or not it will be filing a recommendation regarding the application and approximately when such recommendation will be filed.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That no later than March 16, 2000, the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file a report advising the Commission as to the status of the Joint Application to Transfer Assets and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity filed by JATO Communications Corp. and JATO Operating Corp.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on February 25, 2000.
