ORDER EXTENDING FILING DATE

On January 20, 1999, Ozark Shores Water Company (Ozark), Summerhaven Condominium Owners Association, Waterserv Inc., and the Commission Staff (the parties) met for a prehearing conference. On January 20, Ozark filed a motion to extend the date on which the proposed procedural schedule is due. Ozark states that, as a result of discussions at that prehearing, it believes a settlement of the issues is possible, and suggests postponing the filing of a proposed procedural schedule to allow further discussions. Ozark filed the motion on behalf of the parties¹. The Commission will grant the requested extension.

¹ The Office of the Public Counsel did not attend the prehearing conference, and did not file a response to the motion to extend the filing date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than April 9, 1999. The procedural schedule shall include dates for the filing of testimony and for a hearing.
2. That this order shall become effective on February 11, 1999.
