ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE PRIVATE  
PAY PHONE SERVICE

On May 27, 1998, Steve Gauvain, d/b/a Cardinal Communications, was granted a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service. On March 5, 1999, Steve Gauvain filed a letter with the Commission by which he requested that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority. Mr. Gauvain's letter indicates that he never conducted business as a private pay telephone provider.

Mr. Gauvain's request will be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Private Pay Telephone Service that was granted to Steve Gauvain, d/b/a Cardinal Communications, in Case No. TA-98-447, is canceled.

2. That this order shall become effective on March 19, 1999.

3. That this case may be closed on March 20, 1999.
