ORDER DIRECTING COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

On August 5, 1999, the Public Service Commission issued an order approving the application filed by Primus Telecommunications, Inc. (Primus) and Telegroup, Inc. (Telegroup) for authority to transfer to Primus the assets (including customer base) of Telegroup. The application represented that upon completion of the transfer of assets, Telegroup would no longer provide telecommunications service in Missouri. The application also indicated that Telegroup would notify the Commission of its intent to cancel its existing certificate after the transaction was complete.

The second ordered paragraph of the August 5 order directed Primus to make the necessary tariff filing to add Telegroup's services and rates to the Primus tariff no later than September 14. Primus has complied with that provision of the order by filing an appropriate tariff that was approved by the Commission on October 12. However, the third ordered paragraph of that order directed Telegroup to file a motion to cancel its certificate of service authority and tariff upon completion

of the transaction. Telegroup has not complied with that provision of the order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That no later than December 23, 1999, Telegroup, Inc. shall comply with the Commission's Order of August 5, 1999 by filing a motion to cancel its certificate of service authority and accompanying tariffs.
- 2. That Telegroup, Inc. is advised that failure to comply with an order of the Commission may subject it to the penalties set forth at Sections 386.570 and 386.580, RSMo (1994).
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on December 3, 1999.
