ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On March 17, 2000, AccuTel of Texas, Inc. (AccuTel) filed its application requesting the Commission's approval of a resale agreement under the Telecommunications Act of 1996. The application identified the party by legal name but provided no specific information about the applicant.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A) requires that, in addition to the legal name of the applicants, the application shall include the street and mailing address of the principal office or place of business of the applicants. AccuTel's application fails to comply with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A) because it does not include the street and mailing address of the principal office or place of business of the applicant.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(B) requires that the application shall include a brief statement of the character of business performed by the applicant. AccuTel's application fails to comply with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(B) because it does not

include a brief statement of the character of business performed by the applicant.

The Commission finds that AccuTel's application requesting approval of the resale agreement fails to comply with Commission rules 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A) and (B), and is, therefore, deficient. The Commission will order AccuTel to comply with these Commission rules.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That AccuTel of Texas, Inc. is directed to file its amended application in compliance with Commission rules 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A) and (B) no later than 4:00 p.m. on April 3, 2000.
