## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On March 24, 2000, Universal Telecom, Inc. (UTI), filed an application requesting a certificate of service authority to provide resold basic local telecommunications services within the state of Missouri. UTI requested the Commission grant a certificate of service authority to provide resold basic local telecommunications services in all exchanges currently served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, GTE Midwest Incorporated, and Sprint Missouri, Inc.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H) requires that all applications for certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services include a proposed tariff with a forty-five (45) day effective date. UTI's application does not comply with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H) because it does not include a proposed tariff or request a waiver of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H).

UTI's application for resold basic local telecommunications services fails to comply with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H) and is, therefore, deficient. UTI is directed to comply with

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H), or seek a variance of the rule as ordered below.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Universal Telecom, Inc., shall file its proposed tariff in compliance with rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H), or seek a variance of the rule no later than April 17, 2000.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on April 11, 2000.
