ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

On December 21, 1998, USX Consultants, Inc. (Applicant) filed a pleading asking the Commission to cancel its Certificate of Service Authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services. The Commission had granted Applicant's Certificate of Service Authority on March 30, 1994, in Case No. TA-94-209.

Applicant states that it has notified all affected customers of its intent to discontinue service on the last three billing statements.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its memorandum on January 20, 1999, in which stated that Staff had no objection to USX's request to cancel its certificate of service authority.

The Commission has reviewed the application and the official file and finds that the Certificate of Service Authority granted to Applicant in Case No. TA-94-209 shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Certificate of Service Authority granted to USX Consultants, Inc. in Case No. TA-94-209 is canceled.

- That this order shall become effective on February 4,
 - 3. That this case may be closed on February 5, 1999.
