## ORDER DIRECTING COMPLIANCE

On November 4, 1999, the Commission issued an order that approved the interconnection agreement between GTE Midwest Incorporated and GTE Arkansas Incorporated (GTE) and St. Louis Paging Network, Inc., d/b/a Dial-A-Page (DAP). That order directed the parties to file a copy of the interconnection agreement with the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), with the pages numbered seriatim in the lower right-hand corner, no later than November 16, 1999. The parties were also ordered to file on the same date a notice in the official case file advising the Commission that the agreement has been submitted to Staff as required. The parties have not yet complied with this portion of the Commission's order.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That GTE Midwest Incorporated and GTE Arkansas Incorporated and St. Louis Paging Network, Inc., d/b/a Dial-A-Page, shall file, no later than December 29, 1999, a copy of the interconnection agreement with the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, with the pages numbered

seriatim in the lower right-hand corner. The parties are also ordered to file on the same date a notice in the official case file advising the Commission that the agreement has been submitted to Staff as required.

- 2. That GTE Midwest Incorporated and GTE Arkansas Incorporated and St. Louis Paging Network, Inc., d/b/a Dial-A-Page, are advised that failure to comply with an order of the Commission may subject them to penalties set forth at Sections 386.570 and 386.580, RSMo 1994.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on December 28, 1999.
