ORDER APPROVING MOTION TO RETURN SURETY BOND

On January 20, 2000, Everest Connections Corporation (Everest) filed its application requesting the Commission to grant it a certificate of service authority pursuant to Chapter 392 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. On March 27, 2000, Everest supplemented its application and submitted a surety bond in the amount of \$100,000.00. This bond was filed in the Commission's case file for this proceeding. On March 30, 2000, Everest filed a motion requesting that withdrawal of the bond and its return to Everest's counsel.

In its motion, Everest states the Commission's Staff has indicated certain changes should be made to the terms of the bond. Everest states that its bonding company requires the return of the original bond in order to make these changes. Everest states that it has discussed this matter with the Commission's Staff and that Staff has no objection to the return of the bond.

Granting Everest's motion will allow it to proceed with the changes necessary to complete Everest's application. Based on the representations by Everest and the fact that the Commission has not acted upon Everest's application, the bond shall be returned as requested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Commission's records department shall return the original surety bond filed by Everest Connections Corporation to Everest's counsel.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on April 5, 2000.
