ORDER EXTENDING EFFECTIVE DATE


On October 5, 1999, the Commission issued an order dismissing this case pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.116(2). On October 14, Waterserv, Inc. (Waterserv) filed an application for rehearing. Waterserv asserts that an agreement has been reached among the parties, and that it believes a stipulation can be filed within the next twenty days. The Commission will extend the effective date of the order dismissing this case to allow the parties the opportunity to file a stipulation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the effective date of the Order Dismissing Case issued October 5, 1999 is extended until November 9, 1999.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 29, 1999.
