ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME AND APPROVING REVISED TARIFF

On November 12, 1999, Frontier Telemanagement, Inc. (FTI), submitted a replacement tariff with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) which had an effective date of December 15, 1999, designed to reflect that it has changed its corporate name to Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc., and to make other revisions. FTI also filed a registration of a fictitious name and an amended certificate of authority of a foreign corporation, both issued by the Missouri Secretary of State, dated October 27, 1999, showing the new name, Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. On December 10, 1999, FTI filed substitute tariff sheets and extended the effective date of the tariff to December 30, 1999.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum on December 20, 1999, stating that it had reviewed FTI's filings and revised tariff and had no objection to their approval. Staff recommended that the name change be recognized and the revised tariff be approved to become effective December 30, 1999.

The Commission has reviewed FTI's filings, the revised tariff, and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the change of name should be recognized. The Commission further finds that the revised tariff should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the change of name from Frontier Telemanagement, Inc. to Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. is acknowledged.
- 2. That Tariff No. 200000447, filed November 12, 1999, by Frontier Telemanagement, Inc., consisting of the following tariff sheets, is hereby approved for service on or after December 30, 1999:

- 3. That this order shall become effective on December 30, 1999.
- 4. That this case may be closed on December 31, 1999.
