

MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COME NOW Complainants, and for their Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule, state to the Commission as follows:


1. The current procedural schedule in these consolidated cases provides that Complainants' Surrebuttal Testimony shall be filed no later than 3:00 p.m. on June 26, 2000. However, that schedule allowed for a full four (4) weeks after the rebuttal testimony deadline. Complainants request the preservation of that full four (4) weeks response time in light of SWBT's submission of rebuttal testimony on May 31, two days after the original date, pursuant to a motion for additional time.

2. Complainants respectfully request the Commission modify the procedural schedule to provide that Complainants' Surrebuttal Testimony shall be filed no later than 3:00 p.m. on June 28, 2000 (two days later than the current date).

3. Counsel for Complainants has discussed this matter with SWBT's counsel and SWBT's counsel agrees that the procedural schedule may be modified to provide that Complainants' Surrebuttal Testimony shall be filed no later than 3:00 p.m. on June 28, 2000.
