

**ORDER REOPENING CASE AND DIRECTING FILING**

On January 18, 2000, the Commission issued its order granting the joint application by CEO Telecommunications, Inc., and L.D. Services, Inc., for approval of a merger of the two companies with L.D. Services, Inc., surviving and adopting the name CEO Telecommunications, Inc. (the "Company"). The survivor was directed to file, within 30 days of the effective date of that order, an adoption notice or a replacement tariff (30-day effective date) to complete its name change.

On February 4, 2000, the Company filed its adoption notice to support its name change. The Commission's Staff recommended approval of the adoption notice on February 29, 2000, and on March 1, 2000, the Commission issued its order that recognized the name change and closed this case.

Beginning March 1, 2000, the Commission's notices to the Company, including the final order in this case, have been returned to the Commission by the United States Postal Service as undeliverable at 12440 Firestone Boulevard., Suite 3000, Norwalk, California 90650. This

is the address the Company's Missouri counsel provided in the application for merger filed on August 18, 1999.

Companies holding a certificate from the Commission to provide services in Missouri are responsible to maintain a principal address with the Commission. This case is therefore reopened and the Company is directed to file a letter or pleading providing its principal address to the Commission or provide an explanation of whether it intends to discontinue offering its services in Missouri.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Case No. TM-2000-157 is reopened.
2. That CEO Telecommunications, Inc., is directed to file notice of its change of address within ten days of the date of this order, or provide other explanation of whether it intends to discontinue offering its services in Missouri.
3. That this notice and order is effective on March 29, 2000.

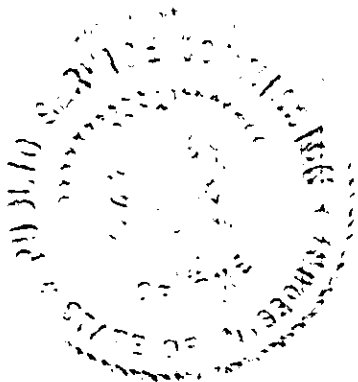
