ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 18, 1994, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) filed tariff sheets designed to increase the charge for certain services. On June 15, 1994, the Commission suspended the tariff sheets from June 20, 1994 to October 18, 1994. On June 30, 1994, a prehearing conference was held as scheduled and on July 8, 1994, the parties filed a proposed procedural schedule.

Inasmuch as the burden to show that the proposed tariff sheets are just and reasonable is upon the party proposing the tariff sheets, the Commission is of the opinion that a hearing should be scheduled at which time MGE shall present its case in support of the proposed tariff sheets. The Commission is also of the opinion that, in order to facilitate the hearing process, a procedural schedule should be established; all parties should be required to file prepared testimony; and all parties should be required to file supporting or relied upon documents concurrent with the filing of testimony.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:
