**ORDER CONTINUING HEARING,  
FURTHER SUSPENDING TARIFFS, AND ESTABLISHING DATE  
FOR FILING OF PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On October 20, 1994, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) filed a motion in this case requesting the Commission to (1) further suspend its tariffs to establish rate bands for transitionally competitive services, (2) continue the hearing scheduled for October 24-26, 1994, and (3) direct the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule on or before November 3, 1994. SWB states that recent rate changes for certain services and changes in the Primary Toll Carrier for certain exchanges, as well as the unavailability of a witness, necessitate the continuance and establishment of an amended procedural schedule. SWB indicates that no parties oppose its motion.

The Commission has considered SWB's motion and will grant the continuance as requested. The Commission will also suspend the tariffs to the operation of law date and direct the parties to file a new procedural schedule. The issues in this case concern rate bands for SWB's transitionally competitive services and it is important that the most up-to-date information possible be used in considering the reasonableness of the maximum and minimum rates in the bands.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the hearing scheduled for October 24-26, 1994, in this case is hereby continued to a date to be fixed.

2. That the tariffs establishing rate bands for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's transitionally competitive services are hereby suspended from January 1, 1995, to April 29, 1995.

3. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule in this matter on or before November 3, 1994, with hearings no later than the week of February 27, 1995.

4. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
