## ORDER AND NOTICE

On June 29, 1999, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T), filed a pleading requesting that the Commission terminate its obligation under Section 392.460, RSMo, to be the basic interexchange telecommunications services provider of last resort.

The Commission determines that proper persons should be allowed an opportunity to file an application to intervene.
