ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Bell) filed tariff sheets pursuant to the Report and Order issued by the Commission in Case No. TO-92-306 on December 23, 1992, and the Order of Implementation issued by the Commission on November 10, 1993. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the tariff sheets for service on and after January 13, 1994.
