## ORDER MODIFYING CERTIFICATE

)

On July 24, 1992, the Commission granted a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service to Cherry Payment Systems, Inc. (CPS), an Illinois corporation. On May 2, 1994, CPS made a verbal request that its certificate be amended to reflect the new corporate name of Cherry Communications Incorporated. A copy of the articles of amendment and the certificate of authorization from the Missouri Secretary of State have been filed with the Commission.

On November 3, 1994, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission change the name on the certificate to Cherry Communications Incorporated. Staff stated that the information supplied by CPS was acceptable and it had no objections to its request.

Upon review of CPS' request and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that CPS' request is reasonable. Thus, the Commission determines that the certificate granted to CPS should be modified to reflect its new name of Cherry Communications Incorporated.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the certificate of service authority granted to Cherry
Payment Systems, Inc. shall be modified to reflect the holder as Cherry
Communications Incorporated.
