ORDER ESTABLISHING DOCKET AND ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

As a result of a prehearing conference held in Case No. TO-90-1, the parties submitted a proposed procedural schedule for Commission consideration of future alternative regulation plans for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB). As part of the procedural schedule the parties propose that Case No. TO-90-1 remain open for consideration of issues regarding the credits, if any, owed under the terms of the existing incentive regulation plan, which has been extended until January 1, 1994. In addition, the parties propose that a separate docket be established for consideration of future alternative regulation plans. The parties also request that the procedural schedule proposed for future alternative regulation plans also be established for any general rate case filed by SWB or any complaint cases filed by either Staff or the Office of Public Counsel.

The Commission finds the proposals of the parties to TO-90-1 with regard to the establishment of a separate docket and the procedural schedule to be reasonable. Case No. TO-93-192 will be established for consideration of future alternative regulation for SWB. The procedural schedule proposed will also be adopted. As indicated by the parties, the hearings cannot be scheduled for the week of July 26 through July 30, 1993 because of the summer NARUC

meetings. If an additional week of hearings is necessary, it will have to be scheduled in August 1993 as proposed. The Commission will adopt this procedural schedule for any general rate case or complaint case filed before February 1, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Case No. TO-93-192 be hereby established to consider a future alternative regulation plan for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company. The case style shall be: "In the matter of proposals to establish an alternative regulation plan for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company."
- 2. That the following procedural schedule be hereby established for Case No. TO-93-192:
