- 1. On February 22, 2007, the Commission issued its *Order Adopting Procedural Schedule and Approving Motion to Modify Suspension Order and Notice*. Therein, the Commission directed that the parties file by July 30, 2007, a Final List of Issues, List of Witnesses, Order of Cross-Examination, Order of Opening, Final Reconciliation. On July 30, 2007, the Commission issued its order extending the deadline for this filing to August 1, 2007.
- 2. The following parties are referenced by this pleading: Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), the Staff of the Commission (Staff), Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel), Utility Workers Union of America Local 335 (UWUA Local 335), City of Joplin (Joplin), AG Processing Inc. (AGP), Missouri Energy Group (MEG), City of Warrensburg (Warrensburg), Public Water Supply District Nos. 1 and 2 of Andrew County and Public Water Supply District No. 1 of DeKalb County (Water Districts), Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC), City of St. Joseph (St. Joseph), Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD), City of Jefferson (Jefferson City), the City of Parkville (Parkville) and the Home Builders Association of St. Louis and Eastern Missouri. <u>Pension/OPEB Methodology:</u> How should pension and OPEB expense be treated for purposes of the revenue requirement and how should it be accounted for on a going forward basis?

<u>Amortization of Pension/OPEB assets:</u> What is the appropriate level of expense to be included in MAWC's cost of service related to recovery of the regulatory asset created by the transition to accrual accounting for pensions and OPEBs?

<u>Insurance Other than Group:</u> What is the appropriate level of expense to be included in MAWC's cost of service related to insurance other than group?

<u>Uncollectible-Present Rates:</u> What amount of uncollectibles/bad debt should be included in MAWC's cost of service?

<u>Uncollectible-Rate Increase:</u> Should the uncollectibles/bad debt expense be adjusted to reflect the total revenues, including any rate increase in Missouri jurisdictional retail revenues awarded in this proceeding?

<u>Audit Fees:</u> What is the appropriate level of expense to be included in MAWC's cost of service related to audit fees for Sarbanes-Oxley compliance?

<u>Tank Painting Expense:</u> What is the appropriate level of expense to be included in MAWC's cost of service related to tank painting expense?

<u>Capitalized Software:</u> Should any of the costs associated with computer software and/or maintenance agreements be capitalized? If so, what amount?
