ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Bell) filed tariff sheets pursuant to the Report and Order issued by the Commission in Case No. TO-92-306 on December 23, 1992, and the Orders of Implementation issued by the Commission on October 22, 26, and 29, 1993. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the tariff sheets for service on and after November 1, 1993.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Bell's proposed tariff sheets are in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. TO-92-306 and its Orders of Implementation of October 22, 26, and 29, 1993. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheets filed by Bell should be approved for service on and after November 1, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the following tariff sheets filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company are hereby approved for service on and after November 1, 1993:
