ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

W2COM International, LLC (W2COM) applied to the Public Service Commission on December 21, 1999, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Section 392.440, RSMo 1994¹. W2COM asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and to waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. Applicant is an Ohio corporation, with its principal office located at 3500 Park Center Drive, Dayton, Ohio 45414.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications and Opportunity to Intervene on December 28, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by January 12, 2000. The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party

has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). Since no one has asked permission to intervene or requested a hearing, the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the verified application.

W2COM filed a proposed tariff in conjunction with its application and filed substitute sheets on January 14. The tariff's effective date is February 9. W2COM's tariff describes the rates, rules, and regulations it intends to use, identifies W2COM as a competitive company, and lists the waivers requested. W2COM intends to provide interexchange telecommunications services including 1+, 800/888/877, Directory Assistance, and Travel Card services.

In its Recommendation and Memorandum filed on January 24 the Staff of the Commission stated that W2COM's proposed services are similar to existing IXC offerings. Staff recommended that the Commission grant W2COM a certificate of service authority, competitive status, and waiver of the statutes and rules listed in the Notice. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff as amended to become effective on February 9.

The Commission finds that competition in the intrastate interexchange telecommunications market is in the public interest and W2COM should be granted a certificate of service authority. The Commission finds that the services W2COM proposes to offer are competitive and W2COM should be classified as a competitive company. The

Commission finds that waiving the statutes and Commission rules set out in the ordered paragraph below is reasonable and not detrimental to the public interest.

The Commission finds that W2COM's proposed tariff details the services, equipment, and pricing it proposes to offer, and is similar to tariffs approved for other Missouri certificated interexchange carriers. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff filed on December 21 shall be approved as amended to become effective on February 9.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That W2COM International, LLC is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.
- 2. That W2COM International, LLC is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. Application of the following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:


