

RESPONSE TO COMMISSION'S SECOND ORDER REQUESTING RESPONSE

COMES NOW Capsule Communications, Inc., ("Capsule" or "Applicant"), by and through counsel, and states its Response to the Commission's Second Order Requesting Response:

1. On March 3, 2000, Capsule filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") its application for a Certificate of Service Authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri.


2. On March 13, 2000, Staff filed its recommendation for approval of the application. In its recommendation, however, Staff indicated that among the services Capsule was seeking to provide was Private Line service.

3. By order dated March 16, 2000, the Commission issued an Order directing Staff, and Capsule if desired, to respond to the following question: "Can an interexchange carrier provide private line services without local exchange authority?"

4. In response to the Commission's Order, Capsule would like to clarify that it is not seeking to provide local exchange private line services. By its application and tariff, Capsule requests authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service only.

WHEREFORE, Capsule Communications, Inc., requests the Commission approve its Application for interexchange service authority and tariff as expeditiously as possible.


