## RECOMMENDATION REGARDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE FOR THE FILING OF TESTIMONY RELATING TO LACLEDE'S WEATHER MITIGATION PROPOSALS IN CASE NO. GT-2001-662

COMES NOW Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede" or "Company"), and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080, submits this Recommendation regarding procedural dates for the filing of testimony relating to weather mitigation proposals submitted in Case No. GT-2001-662. In support thereof, Laclede states as follows:

- 1. On April 20, 2001, Laclede filed revised and specimen tariff sheets to implement a proposed weather mitigation clause. In the same filing, Laclede also submitted for the Commission's consideration several other weather mitigation proposals designed to address the impact of weather on Laclede's customers' bills. Laclede's filing was subsequently assigned Case No. GT-2001-662.
- 2. On October 4, 2001, the Commission issued an order directing that Case No. GT-2001-662 be consolidated with Case No. GR-2001-629. The Commission stated that "the most appropriate place to address Laclede's proposed tariff and the rate design proposal is in Laclede's pending rate case, GR-2001-629." (See Commission Order in Case No. GT-2001-662, pp. 3-4).

3. To accommodate the consolidation, Laclede, after consultation with the other parties to this case, recommends that the procedural schedule already adopted by the Commission in Case No. GR-2001-629 be used for addressing the proposals in Case No. GT-2001-662. Currently, the schedule for Case No. GR-2001-629 is as follows:

4. Laclede recommends that consistent with the above schedule that the testimony filing dates for all of the issues relevant to the Company's weather mitigation proposals in Case No. GT-2001-662, including issues relating to their impact, if any, on the revenue requirement in this Case No. GR-2001-629 be set as follows:

Laclede files Direct Testimony on Weather Mitigation Proposals

October 16, 2001

All Parties file Rebuttal Testimony on Weather Mitigation Proposals

November 21, 2001

All Parties' file Surrebuttal Testimony on Weather Mitigation Proposals

December 6, 2001

The remainder of the schedule, including the evidentiary hearings and briefs, would proceed according to the above dates for both Case No. GR-2001-629 and Case No. GT-2001-662.

5. Laclede has contacted counsel for the Staff, Office of the Public Counsel, the Paper Allied-Industrial, Chemical and Energy Workers Local No. 5-6, AFL-CIO, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers<sup>1</sup> and all have indicated that they have no objection to the recommendations set forth herein.
