## MIDWEST ISO'S RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER

Comes now Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO), and for its response to the Commission's January 9, 2008 Order states the following to the Commission:

- 1. With the exception of the dates set for hearing, Midwest ISO supports Staff's proposed modifications to the approved procedural schedule, presuming that the modifications to the testimony deadlines and later dates for hearing will resolve any and all objections to the filing of Mr. Pfeifenberger's supplemental rebuttal. Because of a conflict on April 14, Midwest ISO proposes that the hearing be scheduled for three days commencing on April 15 and ending on April 17, 2008, and if not on those days, then on some three day block shortly thereafter.
- 2. Furthermore Midwest ISO agrees, whether or not the Commission may enter an order changing the time period for responding to data requests, that 1) objections to data requests submitted to Midwest ISO will be due within five days of service of the same, and 2) Midwest ISO will use its best efforts to respond to data requests within ten to fifteen days of service.
