ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME
AND APPROVING ADOPTION NOTICE

Kansas City Cable Partners d/b/a American Cablevision (Time) submitted an adoption notice on September 3, 1999, designed to reflect that it has changed its corporate name to Kansas City Cable Partners d/b/a Time Warner Cable. On the same date, Time filed a revised title page to its tariff with an effective date of October 15, 1999, an adoption notice with an effective date of October 15, 1999, and a registration of a fictitious name from the Missouri Secretary of State, dated May 10, 1999, showing the new name, Kansas City Cable Partners d/b/a Time Warner Cable. On September 30, 1999, Time filed a revised title page to its tariff with an effective date of October 30, 1999, and an adoption notice with an effective date of October 30, 1999. On October 14, 1999, Time filed additional substitute sheets.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum on October 19, 1999, stating that it had reviewed Time's filing and adoption notice and had no objection to their approval. Staff recommended that the name change be recognized and the adoption notice approved to become effective October 30, 1999.

The Commission has reviewed Time's filing, the adoption notice, and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the change of name should be recognized. The Commission further finds that the adoption notice reflecting the change of name should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the change of name from Kansas City Cable Partners d/b/a American Cablevision to Kansas City Cable Partners d/b/a Time Warner Cable is acknowledged.
2. That the adoption notice denominated Mo. P.S.C. No. 1, Adoption Notice is approved to become effective on October 30, 1999.
3. That this order shall become effective on October 30, 1999.
4. That this case may be closed on October 31, 1999.
