ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: April 25, 2011

Effective Date: May 5, 2011

On March 25, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Guest Communications' certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-90-223, the Commission granted Guest Communications a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Guest Communications has reported no jurisdictional revenue in annual reports for the years 2008 and 2009. Staff notes that it is not in the public interest to allow telecommunication companies to retain their certificates of service authority if they have not conducted business in Missouri for over a year. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel Guest Communications' certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service.

On March 28, 2011, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than April 7, 2011. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Guest Communications, shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide private pay telephone services granted to Guest Communications, in File Number TA-90-223, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on April 25, 2011.
3. This case may be closed on May 5, 2011.
