portions of Camden County, Missouri.

ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 28, 1994, Osage Water Company (Osage) filed an amended application in this case. On May 18, 1994, the Commission directed that notice be provided and that applications to intervene be filed by June 17, 1994. Various applications to intervene and an application to participate without intervention were timely filed, and on July 22, 1994, the Commission granted all such applications. On August 8, 1994, the parties filed a proposed procedural schedule.

The Commission is of the opinion that a hearing should be scheduled at which time Osage shall present its case in support of its application. The Commission is also of the opinion that, in order to facilitate the hearing process, a procedural schedule should be established, and all parties should be required to file prepared testimony and supporting or relied upon documents.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following procedural schedule is hereby established for this case:
