ORDER CANCELING SERVICE AUTHORITY

On March 23, 1989, the Commission granted a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service to the Little Sisters of the Poor (Sisters). On April 30, 1993, the Commission received a written request from the Sisters to cancel their certificate of service authority.

On May 6, 1993, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority which had been granted to the Sisters. Staff stated that the Sisters do not own any payphones and that all payphones at their facilities are operated by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company.

Based upon Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines that the certificate of service authority granted to the Sisters in this case should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the certificate of service authority issued to the Little Sisters of the Poor is hereby canceled.
 - 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
