ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On April 12, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority. Staff requested that the Commission cancel Trintel Communications, Inc.'s private pay telephone service certificate of service authority. The Commission granted that certificate in Case No. TA-93-332.

Staff stated that Trintel should no longer have the certificate because the Missouri Secretary of State revoked its authority to conduct business in Missouri due to a failure to file its annual report. Also, Staff states that Trintel asked the Commission to cancel its certificate. Staff included Trintel's correspondence with its motion.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) states that parties have 10 days to respond to motions. Trintel failed to timely respond to Staff's motion.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, and finds that it should cancel Trintel's private pay telephone service certificate of service authority.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority is granted.
- 2. That the private pay telephone service certificate of service authority granted to Trintel Communications, Inc., in Case No. TA-93-332, is canceled.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on May 7, 2005.
 - 4. That this case may be closed on May 8, 2005.
