ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On June 25, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Community Payphones, Inc.'s certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-99-.45, the Commission granted Community Payphones a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Community Payphones notified the Staff of the Commission indicating the Company no longer wished to retain its certificate. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel Community Payphones' certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service.

On June 26, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than July 6, 2012. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority

may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion and the Company's request, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Community Payphones, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The certificate of authority to provide private pay telephone services granted to Community Payphones, Inc., in File Number TA-99-378, is canceled.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on July 20, 2012.
 - 3. This case may be closed on July 21, 2012.
