In the matter of I.H. Utilities, Inc.'s tariff revisions ) designed to increase rates for water service pursuant to ) Case No. WR-95-57 the Commission's informal rate procedure.

## ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On August 23, 1994, I.H. Utilities, Inc. (Company) filed a tariff pursuant to the small company rate case procedure, 4 CSR 240-2.060(8), designed to increase annual revenues by \$3,982. The Commission Staff and the Office of Public Counsel have agreed that the increase is reasonable and supported by an audit of Company's records. The tariff was to be effective for service on and after October 7, 1994.

On October 4, 1994, the Commission issued an order suspending the tariff to January 28, 1995, because Company had not filed its 1993 annual report and did not have an agreement for paying its assessment as required by Commission rules. On January 12, 1995, Staff filed a memorandum indicating that Company has complied with these two requirements. Staff also recommended that the tariff be suspended until February 1, 1995, and approved for service after that date to coordinate with Company's billing cycle.

The Commission finds that Company has satisfied the requirements which caused the suspension of its tariff. The Commission will therefore approve the tariff as recommended by Staff by first suspending it to February 1, 1995, and then approving the tariff for service effective that date.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the tariff filed by I.H. Utilities, Inc., to increase rates for water service on August 23, 1994, is hereby suspended beyond January 28, 1995, to February 1, 1995.
- 2. That the tariff filed by I.H. Utilities, Inc., to increase rates for water service is approved for service on and after February 1, 1995.
