## ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On July 15, 1994, Union Electric Company (UE) filed with the Commission proposed tariff sheets to allow UE to engage in special transportation rate contracts with industrial and other large scale customers, where UE is facing competition from other suppliers of natural gas service. The proposed tariff has an effective date of August 15, 1994.

On July 19, 1994, the Staff of the Commission filed its recommendation in this matter, stating that the proposed tariff is designed to give UE flexibility in dealing with competition for large customers which poses competitive or bypass pressure on UE. The Staff stated that the proposed tariff provision is virtually identical to those previously approved for use by three other large LDC's in the state. The Energy Department of the Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff and recommends it be approved in an expedited fashion, at UE's request.

After review of the proposed tariff and the recommendation of the Staff, the Commission finds the proposed tariff to be reasonable and in the public interest and will approve the tariff for service, in an expedited fashion, on or after August 1, 1994.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the proposed tariff, filed by Union Electric Company on July 15, 1994, be approved for service on or after August 1, 1994:

- 2. That the Commission reserves the right to consider the ratemaking treatment to be afforded these transactions in any later rate proceeding.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective August 1, 1994.
