ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On February 9, 1990, the Commission issued a Report and Order in this matter which authorized GTE North Incorporated (GTE) to file tariffs which reflected an increase in general revenue requirement of \$849,000. This increase was to be received based upon the rate design approved by the Commission in the Report and Order. GTE filed tariffs on February 22, 1990, to implement the approved rate increase. The Commission on February 24, 1990, rejected the tariffs filed by GTE as not in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order.

On February 28, 1990, GTE filed a new set of tariffs to comply with the Commission's Report and Order. Commission Staff has reviewed these new tariffs and recommends the Commission approve them as in compliance with the Report and Order.

The Commission has determined that the tariffs filed by GTE on February 28, 1990, will be approved for service on and after March 1, 1990. Based upon Staff's

review, the Commission finds these tariffs comply with the Commission's Report and Order.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the tariffs filed by GTE North Incorporated on February 28, 1990, are hereby approved for service on and after March 1, 1990.

ORDERED: 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
