SECOND ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 7, 1998, the Commission issued an Order Granting Intervention and Directing Filing of Procedural Schedule, directing the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by January 19, 1999. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Suspend Filing of the Proposed Procedural Schedule on January 19. Staff noted that the parties were in the process of negotiating and expected to file a unanimous stipulation and agreement with the Commission. On January 26, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Procedural Schedule in which it suspended the filing of the procedural schedule until February 9 in order to allow the parties time to file a stipulation and agreement.

On February 9, 1999, the Staff filed a Second Motion to Suspend Filing of the Proposed Procedural Schedule. The motion indicates that the parties continue to negotiate and expect to file a unanimous stipulation and agreement with the Commission. The Staff requests that the Commission further suspend the filing of the proposed procedural schedule until February 23, 1999, to afford the

parties an opportunity to reach an agreement, or in the alternative, to file a proposed procedural schedule.

The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds that the request is reasonable and should be granted. The filing of the procedural schedule shall be suspended.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Second Motion to Suspend Filing of the Proposed Procedural Schedule filed by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission on February 9, 1999, is granted. The filing of the procedural schedule is suspended until March 4, 1999, in order to allow the parties time to complete and file a stipulation and agreement, or in the alternative, a proposed procedural schedule.
- 2. That this order shall become effective on February 25, 1999.


