ORDER CLOSING CASE

On May 7, 1998, the Commission issued its Order Granting Certificate of Service Authority that granted a certificate of service authority to Group Long Distance, Inc. (GLD). The order provided that the applicant was granted a waiver of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H), which requires the filing of a proposed tariff with a 45-day effective date. The order also provided that the applicant was to file its proposed tariff within 30 days of the Commission's approval of an interconnection agreement with the underlying local exchange carrier. The applicant was to file the proposed tariff in this case and give notice of the filing to all the parties and participants. Along with that filing, the order directed GLD to provide a written disclosure of all interconnection agreements which affect its Missouri service areas, all portions of Missouri service areas for which it does not have an interconnection agreement, and an explanation of why no interconnection agreement is necessary for those areas.

This case was held open for the filing of appropriate tariffs. None have been filed. The Commission is unwilling to keep this file

open indefinitely. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.116, the Commission may dismiss a case if no action has taken place for 90 days. Therefore, this file will be closed. The closing of this file will not prevent applicant from filing proposed tariffs in the future, nor will it affect the validity of its certificate of service authority. When applicant does file a proposed tariff as contemplated by the order in this case, it will be assigned a new case number.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That when Group Long Distance, Inc. files a proposed tariff as contemplated in the Order Granting Certificate of Service Authority issued on May 7, 1998, it shall give notice of the tariff filing to all the parties and participants in this case. The cover letter for its tariff filing shall note the identity of all parties receiving notice of the filing. Along with that filing, Group Long Distance, Inc., shall provide a written disclosure of all interconnection agreements affecting its Missouri service area to which it is a party, all portions of Missouri service areas for which it does not have an interconnection agreement, and an explanation of why no interconnection agreement is necessary for those areas.

2. That this order shall become effective on June 28, 1999.

3. That this case may be closed on June 29, 1999.
