**ORDER ESTABLISHING CASE  
AND CANCELING PRIVATE PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE**

Shawn Archambault, President/Owner of Archie Communications, submitted a letter to the Missouri Public Service Commission on May 15, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel Archie Communications' payphone certificate. Archie Communications was granted the certificate on March 28, 1995, in Case No. TA-95-219. The Staff of the Commission advised the Commission that it had made contact with the certificate holder and that the certificate should be canceled because Archie Communications was no longer operating payphones in Missouri.

The original case file in TA-95-219 has been archived and is no longer available for the entry of an order. The Commission will establish a new case for the purpose of maintaining a record of this certificate cancellation. Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Shawn Archambault's letter and Staff's comments and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Archie Communications in Case No. TA-95-219 shall be canceled.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That this case is established for the purpose of maintaining a record of the certificate cancellation.
2. That the private payphone certificate granted to Archie Communications in Case No. TA-95-219 is canceled.
3. That this order shall become effective on July 23, 1998.
4. That this case may be closed on July 24, 1998.
