**ORDER AND NOTICE**

On September 21, 1998, Citizens Electric Corporation (Citizens) filed an application with the Commission, pursuant to Section 393.140, RSMo, for an order (1) approving a requested tariff, and (2) authorizing the electric power service agreement between Citizens and Proctor and Gamble Paper Products Company.

Proper parties should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. The Records Department of the Commission shall send a copy of this order to County Commissions located in Citizens' service territory, and to the mayor of Ste. Genevieve, Missouri. The Information Office of the Commission will send notice of this application to the publisher of each newspaper located in Citizens' service territory, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current Official Manual of the State of Missouri, and to members of the Missouri General Assembly representing the counties located in Citizens' service territory.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party is granted intervention and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary and that the Applicant may submit its evidence in support of the application by verified statement. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989).

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Information Office and the Records Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall provide notice as set out herein.

2. That any interested party wishing to intervene in this case shall file an application to do so no later than October 15, 1998. Such applications shall be filed with the Secretary of the Missouri Public

Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, and copies shall be served upon the applicant's representatives as set forth herein.

3. That this Order shall become effective on October 8, 1998.
