**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On May 10, 2000, Union Electric Company, doing business as Ameren UE (UE), filed its Status Report as directed by the Commission. Therein, UE stated that it expected to complete all of the improvements planned for the area served by its Brumley Substation by June 15, 2000. UE stated that it would file another Status Report by June 20, 2000.

On May 23, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Response to UE's Status Report. Therein, Staff stated that it is satisfied with the progress made by UE with respect to the Brumley Substation improvements. Staff stated that it will file a response to UE's June 20th Status Report. Staff also suggested that UE be directed to file another Status Report on September 15, 2000, showing the performance of the improved Brumley Substation during the summer 2000 peak load period. Staff states that it will also file a response to that report.

No party has objected to Staff's suggestions and the period for doing so has passed. The Commission will adopt Staff's suggestions.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Union Electric Company, doing business as AmerenUE, shall file a status report showing the completion of its intended Brumley area improvements on or before July 1, 2000.

2. That Union Electric Company, doing business as AmerenUE, shall file a status report showing the performance of its Brumley area distribution system during the summer season on or before September 15, 2000. This report shall note the time, date, duration, and cause of every service outage in the area served by the Brumley Substation between July 1, 2000, and September 1, 2000.

3. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall, within 15 days of the filing thereof, file a response to the aforementioned status reports of the Union Electric Company doing business as AmerenUE.

4. That this Order shall become effective on June 29, 2000.
