#### ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

On October 14, 1999, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency which indicated that the application of Intercontinental Communications Group, Inc., d/b/a Fusion - Trucker Phone (Fusion) is inconsistent with its proposed tariff and is therefore deficient. The Commission directed Fusion to file, no later than October 25, 1999, either an amended pleading or substitute tariff sheets correcting its request for waiver of statutes and rules so that the application and the proposed tariff are consistent.

Fusion filed, on October 25, 1999, a motion for extension of time to respond to the Commission's order. Fusion indicates that it needs an additional four (4) days, up to and including October 29, 1999, to file the substitute tariff sheets.

The Commission has reviewed Fusion's motion and finds that the request to extend the deadline for filing either an amended pleading or substitute tariff sheets should be granted. The request is reasonable, and will not prejudice any party to this proceeding.

#### **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Commission Order, filed by Intercontinental Communications Group, Inc., d/b/a Fusion - Trucker Phone, is granted and the deadline for filing either an amended pleading or substitute tariff sheets is now October 29, 1999.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 26, 1999.
